What is the church challenge?

The Committee on Outdoor Ministries (CODM) wants to make it easier for first-time campers to experience Camp Monroe this summer. Local Churches are encouraged to support the Presbytery's outdoor ministries program by sponsoring member or local community youth in this year's camp program. This is a wonderful opportunity to get youth involved in a vital Presbytery program and possibly help your church extend its impact in the local community.

The CODM is Challenging each church to sponsor at least one new camper this summer through the Church Challenge program. If the church agrees to sponsor the entire fee for the camper's session, The CODM will make all Discoverer, Creation, and Explorer Camps available to Church Challenge Campers for \$225. (A savings of \$125-\$155.)

The "Not So Fine" Print:

- **Church Challenge Campers must be first time campers.**
- **Churches participating in the challenge must agree to pay the camper's entire camp fee.**
- **Churches wishing to apply the Church Challenge Discount must include the enclosed Church Challenge form with their application.**
- **All Church Challenge participant applications must be postmarked or faxed by April 30th to avoid \$15.00 late fee.**
- **The Church Challenge only applies to Discoverer, Creation, and Explorer Camps.**
