

Directions to Kirkwood from Fayetteville, Elizabethtown, etc.



From Fayetteville get on Highway 87 South and go toward Elizabethtown. Take Hwy 87 Bypass around Elizabethtown until you come to the stoplight which is the intersection of Hwy 87 and Hwy 701. The sign overhead will read 701 North and 242 North Elizabethtown/White Lake Next left.

Turn Left onto 701 North.



Go through Elizabethtown and over the Cape Fear River. About 8 Miles after turning onto 701 North you will reach the intersection of 701 North and 53 East. There is a “Wam Squam” convenience store at the intersection as a land mark. Turn right onto Highway 53 East.



Follow the signs to stay on Hwy 53 for about 44 miles (pass through the town of Harrells, stay straight when you come to a stop sign with Hwy 421) until you come into the town of Burgaw. After you cross the railroad tracks pay look for the first of two



turns you will need to take in short order. Your first turn will be where Hwy 53 and Hwy 117 Business briefly meet and go through town. Take a left at the stoplight just past the courthouse.



At the next intersection, follow the signs to stay on Hwy 117 Business and Hwy 53 by veering right . (Pictured to the left). Very soon afterwards Hwy 53 will split off of 117 to head toward I40. **STAY ON 117 Business** by going straight when 53 forks to the right. (Pictured to the right.)



Hwy 117 Business will end at a stop sign not far after Hwy 53 splits off. (not pictured). Turn left at the stop sign headed north on Hwy 117 toward Wallace. About 4.5 or so



after you take the left onto 117 you'll cross over I-40, this is a good landmark for you to begin looking for your turn onto Camp Kirkwood Road which is 5.3 miles after you turn on 117. At the intersection of Hwy 117 and Camp Kirkwood Road turn left. There is a country store on the right hand corner at the intersection, and also you should look for the sign with the white letters that say "Camp Kirkwood" on your



You've done the hard part. After you make a left onto Camp Kirkwood Road, you'll see a large gate with a cross at the top and a blue and white sign marking your arrival at Kirkwood Camp and



Retreat Center. Turn right into the gate and you've arrived!
