

## Directions to Kirkwood from Laurinburg, Lumberton, Whiteville, Etc.



The easiest way is to get to Highway 74 East (toward Wilmington). About 3 miles before you get to the town of Delco, you'll see an intersection for Highway 11 headed toward Burgaw on your left. A good visible landmark for this turn is a brown sign for Moore's Creek Battlefield which is also at the turn.



You will be on Highway 11 for a while. You'll go straight across at a stop sign with Hwy 87 4.2 miles after you turn on Hwy 11 (intersection not pictured). 12.5 miles after you turn onto Hwy 11 you'll come to where Hwy 11 and Hwy 53 intersect. You will take a right hand turn at the stop sign to head toward Burgaw. At this point 11 and 53 will be running together. You'll be on Hwy 11 North and Hwy 53 East.



Stay on Highway 53 when Hwy 11 splits off about 10 miles after you make the turn onto 53 (not pictured, just go straight at the stop sign when you get there). About 9 miles after you 53 and 11 separate you'll arrive in Burgaw. At the courthouse square after



you cross the railroad tracks be prepared to make the first of two turns that are close to each other. You first turn will be where Hwy 53 and Hwy 117 Business briefly meet and go through town. Take a left at the stoplight just past the courthouse.



At the next intersection, follow the signs to stay on Hwy 117 Business and Hwy 53 by veering right . (Pictured to the left). Very soon afterwards Hwy 53 will split off of 117 to head toward I40. **STAY ON 117 Business** by going straight when 53 forks to the right.



Hwy 117 Business will end at a stop sign not far after Hwy 53 splits off. (not pictured). Turn left at the stop sign headed north on Hwy 117 toward Wallace. About 4.5 or so



after you take the left onto 117 you'll cross over I-40, this is a good landmark for you to begin looking for your turn onto Camp Kirkwood Road which is 5.3 miles after you turn on 117. At the intersection of Hwy 117 and Camp Kirkwood Road turn left. There is a country store on the right hand corner at the intersection, and also you should look for the sign with the white letters that say "Camp Kirkwood" on your



You've done the hard part. After you make a left onto Camp Kirkwood Road, you'll see a large gate with a cross at the top and a blue and white sign marking your arrival at Kirkwood Camp and



Retreat Center. Turn right into the gate and you've arrived!
