Job Description for Summer Camp Counselor Camp Monroe, Laurinburg, North Carolina

Responsible To: Program Director

Camp Monroe Counselors are the heart of the Presbytery's summer programming. Without qualified counselors who want to spend time with campers, the best designed programs will have little chance of success. Most of the ministry that goes on at camp happens between the counselors and campers.

In Camp Monroe model, counselors are paired together (male and female usually) and their cabins function as a family group. For the entirety of the camp Counselors take on the role of parent, teacher, companion, Bible Study and Worship leader, partner, referee, friend, and a host of other roles that cannot be listed here.

Qualifications:

- A Growing Christian
- At least 18 years of age with one year out of high school
- Be able to work cooperatively with others
- Be in good health, able to participate in vigorous activity (swimming, hiking, etc.)
- Be a good communicator especially with elementary and middle school aged youth
- Be patient, fun loving, friendly, sensitive, and able to listen to others

Responsibilities:

- Unless on scheduled break, remain with assigned group of campers at ALL times.
- Guide group activities for the week, including campers in the decision making process
- Manage the safety of a small group by assessing the potential hazards and dangers of a given activity. Administer First Aid and/or CPR when necessary and putting into motion proper emergency procedures
- Follow policies and procedures outlined in staff manual
- Be sensitive to diverse needs of different campers, treating them with love, respect, and sincerity.
- Build your group as a Christian community that respects God, each other, and creation.
- Abide by the community standards formed by the policies of the Presbytery, the Camps, and by the staff.
- Be willing to learn from, have fun and laugh with campers.
- Be willing to serve on support staff when camper numbers do not warrant all counselors leading small groups.
- Be willing to perform other duties as assigned by the Camp Director, Program Director, or Site Manager.
